The following guidelines will be used in the operation and management of Trinity Lutheran Church Cemetery. Adherence to these guidelines will insure that the cemetery remains a place of reverence for present and future lot owners.

- Cemetery lots may be purchased by members of Trinity Lutheran church.
- All graves are to be level with the ground. Corner posts and stone entrances on lots are not permitted unless they are flush with the ground.
- Any live plantings including flowers, shrubs and trees are not permitted.

- Only ground level vases are permitted. Glass vases are not allowed due to possible breakage.
- Cut flowers will be removed at the discretion of maintenance personnel.
- Artificial flowers, wreaths, etc., placed on holiday or anniversary dates shall be removed one month after such date. Decorations remaining after that date will be removed by cemetery personnel.
- Grave markers shall be installed flush with the ground. Foundations for grave markers shall extend six inches on all sides at ground level to facilitate maintenance. The depth of the foundation must be at least 12 inches to provide proper stability and protection against freezing.
- Cemetery assessments such as grave opening and closing costs, burial vaults, and lot costs are to be paid before burial takes place.



- All burials shall be completed with a permanent vault.
- Digging inside the cemetery for any purpose other than an authorized grave opening is not permitted.
- Markers or crosses made of wood or concrete are not permitted. Pipe, fencing, rocks, shells and play toys are not permitted at grave sites.
- Graves and burial expenses for infant burials shall be at no charge.
- Lot owners have the option of selling their lots back to Trinity Lutheran Church at 50% of the original price at the discretion of the Church Council.
