



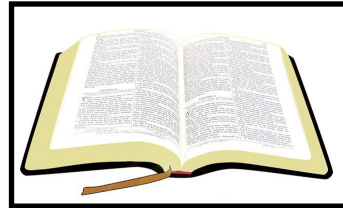
TRINITY PRESCHOOL NEWSLETTER OCTOBER 2022

HALLOWEEN PARTY & PARKING LOT PARADE



Families are asked to arrive at 11:30 and pick up their child's tote bag upon arrival. They will then be able to watch the parade from their car/trunk. The Halloween Parking Lot Parade begins at 11:45, so due to safety, **no cars will be permitted into the parking lot after 11:45.**

Preschool families are invited to attend our Halloween Parking Lot Parade, held on Thursday, October 27 for the T/TH, JK and 4-day classes and Monday, October 31 for the MWF classes.

This is a regular school day for the children until the parade begins at 11:45.

Each child is invited to wear their Halloween costume to

school when they are dropped off in the morning. They will keep their costume on all morning, so costume items such as tights and leotards (which make it difficult when going to the restroom), may need to be left at home.

Please leave any props such as weapons at home!

Immediately, following our parade, parents are asked to pick up their child from their teacher at the curb. Please note: Lunch Bunch will be held on both of our parade days.

Our Class Room Parents will also be organizing a Halloween Party for each class and will be in contact in the next few weeks asking for donations and for volunteers to help during the party.

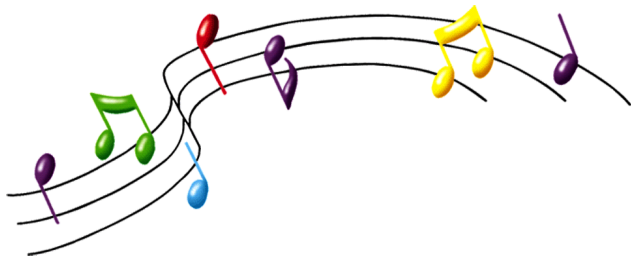
MEALS DO MATTER
