Thank you for your continued support. We have the best families here at Trinity Preschool! We greatly appreciate your "word of mouth" recommendations of our program to your friends and neighbors.

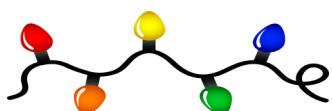
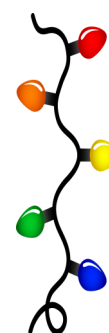

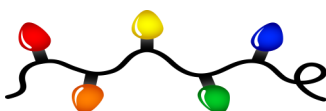
TRINITY CELEBRATES CHRISTMAS!

SPEECH-LANGUAGE SCREENINGS

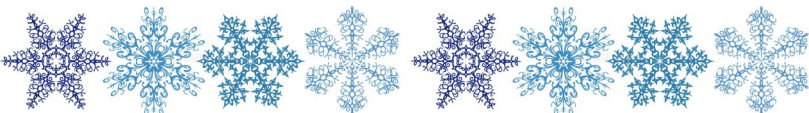
